This loft is situated in a building with an industrial past in the emerging New York TriBeCa neighborhood. It is an example of a proficient response to the requirements of space.

One of the walls that runs the length of the apartment was completely outfitted with builtin closets and shelves. The design reflects the three different living areas. The shelves for the television, books and decorative elements, and the kitchen cabinets, afford ample space for storing and keeping objects. Different steel columns are inserted into the wall of built-ins which visually separate the three areas: bedroom, kitchen-dining room, and living room.
