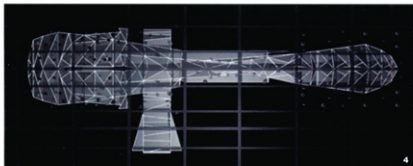
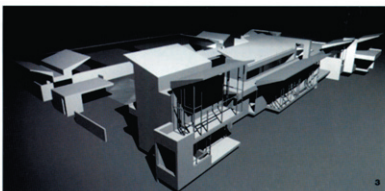

### Design Philosophy

Resolution: 4 Architecture believes in architecture's ability to resonate the human psyche, evoking both an emotional and intellectual response. Through responses to programmatic, economic, political, and social requirements, we attempt to establish, through the design process, a dialogue between the idealized and the pragmatic, between the general and the specific. The development of this discourse allows for aesthetic choices that for us are a rigorous reinterpretation of formal architectural relationships. The analysis of the broad "context" of each problem becomes the foundation for this process. This becomes an intentional response that connects/disconnects similar or disparate elements. It establishes the relationship between form, use, and materials and ultimately expresses an idea and the uniqueness of each client.

### Recent & Current Projects

Previous projects cover a variety of scales, ranging from a bathroom in New York City, to a 600-room hotel in Hawaii, to an office building lobby in Shanghai. Recently completed work includes a golf clubhouse on Long Island, a health club in New York City, and a series of New York residences, most notably an apartment renovation for the architect Peter Eisenman and his family. Projects currently under construction include lofts, Internet companies, an ad agency, and several houses. Current preoccupations are investigations with the ceiling plane as a landscape.
