

Resolution: 4 Architecture, TriBeCa Loft, 1997. This long and narrow former industrial space offered the opportunity to have each living area placed single file: entry, living, dining, kitchen then bedroom. New windows were punched at the extreme end to bring light into the master suite. So the rest of the space could benefit, sliding acrylic panels at once provide privacy while sharing light.
